Commonwealth Games Funding Announcement

Badminton Australia are pleased to announce that it has been awarded a funding allocation of \$151,140 from Commonwealth Games Australia.

The funding is specifically targeted for junior high performance and open sub-elite initiatives; which will include local and international training camps, tournaments and a special provision for the BWF World Junior Championships later this year. Funding will commence in April 2019 and run through till June 2020, giving our junior and open sub-elite athletes unique opportunities and exposure to high level training and competition that they would otherwise miss out on.

BWF World Junior Championships 2019 to be held in Kazan, Russia from the 7th of October to the 13th of October. The World Juniors event brings together all the best junior players from across the globe and gives fans a glimpse at the future stars of Badminton.

Badminton Australia and its players look forward to representing Australia during their preparation for the 2022 Birmingham Commonwealth Games.
