Description & Requirements

After an eight-year hiatus, the Northern Territory Government has brought back the Arafura Games which presents opportunities to showcase our unique arts, culture, history and trade and investment links. It is an event through which friendship and understanding between competing nations and the Northern Territory is fostered.

The Arafura Games 2019 will feature 17 sport disciplines, including, Athletics, Badminton, Basketball, Basketball 3X3 Pro Hustle, Beach Volleyball, Boxing, Football, Indoor Volleyball, Muaythai, Netball, Sailing, Sepak Takraw, Squash, Swimming, Table Tennis, Tennis and Weightlifting,

As the Badminton Junior Team manager, you will be required to ensure the wellbeing and safety of 3 female Junior players competing at the Arafura Games to be held in Darwin from the 30th of April till the 4th of May. The girls will be aged between 13 and 17 and will be representing Australia at the games.

You will be expected to be an excellent role model, and mentor to the junior team.

The position would ideally suit someone who may have experience as a player, coach, or official in sport at a similar level and understands the challenges that come with national and international competitions.

This is an excellent opportunity for a female player or coach that has graduated from the junior ranks into open level competition, to take on a role for your personal development and upskilling, and to encourage and guide our young junior players.

Your flights and accommodation will be covered by BA, you will be responsible for your own meals.
